When introducing new words, the teacher writes a new word on the board. Then the students say the words that can be used together with the given word. For example: Then the teacher asks to make word combinations with the word "computer": my computer, modern computer, expensive computer, etc. motivation. It can be effectively used to improve monologic speech habits and vocabulary skills. Role play. One of the types of activities used in teaching innovative methods is a Role-playing game. They are designed to increase the effectiveness of teaching and learning. The role-playing game engages the students to be active by having a positive effect on their inner workings. This creates favorable conditions for cooperative activity. Such an environment creates their motivation, personal opportunities for their internal activities and allows them to show themselves in the team.
